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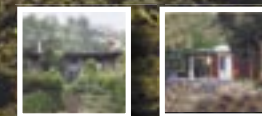

Stone Cottage

The original rustic cottage is comfortably furnished in country style and is set in a private securely fenced cottage garden overlooking sweeping views of the river valley. In summer it stays delightfully cool and a wood fire in winter makes for a snug haven.



Pinewood Cottage

A new pine lined hexagon country style cottage (wheelchair access) with a spacious living area and bathroom, plus two bedrooms, and warmed by a wood fire. The charming cottage faces misty blue ridges, is shaded by a pergola and is set in a fenced private native garden.

An 80 acre property of bush and pasture, Giba Gunyah overlooks lush rolling farmland and is backed by the bushy ridges of the Bemboka National Park. There is lots to do without even leaving the property:

- 🍷 Explore the Bemboka River
- 🍷 Walk the bush trails and fern gullies
- 🍷 Enjoy the wild life and birds
- 🍷 Sit back, relax, look up at the stars
- 🍷 Explore the National Park
